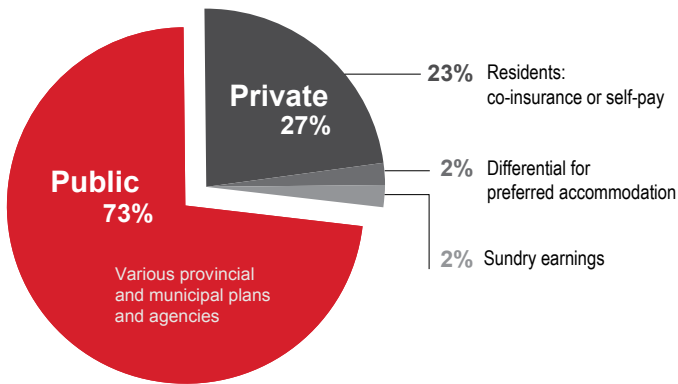


LONG-TERM CARE FUNDING

HOW MUCH IS BEING SPENT?

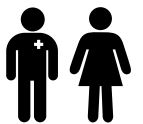

RESIDENT PROFILE

CIHI's clinical data tells us more about residents and the services they receive. For example, in 2013, around:

95% of residents needed at least some assistance with activities of daily living such as bathing, dressing or eating; **more than 80%** of these residents needed extensive assistance with these activities.



40% received physical therapy services.



70% had heart or circulatory diseases.



60% lived with dementia.
